We, the descendants of Joel Hills Johnson and his wives, are recipients of their sacrifice, their pioneering efforts and their love of the Lord Jesus Christ.

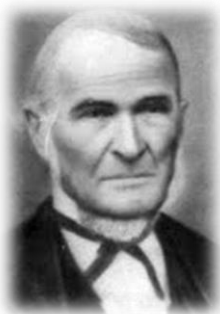
