The Braithwaite Family Organization is a large ancestral family organization whose ancestry goes back hundreds of years to the Braithwaites of Westmorland, England. These early Braithwaites were the progenitors of thousands of descendants who now reside in Western Europe, North America and elsewhere around the world.

In 1843, Rowland Braithwaite (1798-1852) and his wife, Hannah Askew (1804-1875), joined The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in England. In 1863, Hannah Askew Braithwaite, then a widow, left England along with her children and as Mormon Pioneers they sailed to America and then traveled across the Plains to Manti, Utah. Their numerous descendants now support the many family history activities and projects of the Braithwaite Family Organization.



The Braithwaite Family Organization held a reunion on July 14-16, 2016 in Manti, Utah, where they erected a memorial to Hannah Askew Braithwaite (1804-1875), a Mormon Pioneer from England.
